- 4. Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) are fully exempted from payment of the application fees on submission of relevant Disability Certificate issued by the competent authority.
- 5. Applicants already in employment in Government should route their applications through proper channel or produce No Objection Certificate (NOC). Such candidates are also required to produce Integrity Certificate and Vigilance Clearance Certificate at the time of interview, if not submitted earlier.
- 6. For the posts of Assistant Professor and above, applicants willing to join the Institute on deputation may also apply accordingly. The qualification & experience for the applicant willing to join the Institute on deputation will be: Officers holding analogous post on regular basis or post one level below, under the Central/State Government having the requisite qualification and experience prescribed for direct recruits mentioned in the Employment Notice. The period of deputation shall be for a period of three years which may be extended by the Director up to five years in the exigencies of service taking the consent of the lending department.
- 7. The candidates holding DNB qualifications would need to get their qualification verified by NBE as to whether it is as per the requirement of the Gazette notification No.MCI-2(2)/2010-Med.Misc dated 11.06.2012 and to submit such verification certificate along with application.
- 8. Applicants are advised to ensure their eligibility in all respects before applying, that they possess at least the minimum essential qualifications as laid down in the advertisement.
- 9. Mere fulfilling the minimum educational qualification and experience doesn't bestow right to a candidate to be called for interview.

- 35. **Experience Certificate:** All claims of experience shall be supported by an Experience Certificate which is clear and complete in all respects.

- i) The experience certificate shall bear the organization's letter-head, the date of issue, name of post, specific period of work, name and designation of issuing authority along with signature and official seal.
- ii) Appointment letter and such other documents issued at the initial stage of appointment/engagement i.e., before completion of the experience under consideration shall not be accepted as valid proof of the period of work.

B. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR TEACHING POSTS:

I. For Non-Medical Candidates:

- 1. The time taken by candidates to acquire Ph.D and/or M.Phil degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions. Further, the period of active service spent on pursuing Research Degree simultaneously with teaching assignment without taking any kind of leave, shall be counted as teaching experience.
- 2. The National Eligibility Test (NET) or an accredited test (State Level Eligibility Test: SLET/SET) shall remain the minimum eligibility for appointment of Assistant Professor and equivalent positions wherever provided in the UGC (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and other Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) Regulations, 2018.

Provided that candidates who have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their subsequent amendments from time to time, as the case may be, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or any equivalent position in the University/College/Institution.

- 3. For appointment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent positions pertaining to disciplines in which the National Eligibility Test (NET) is conducted by the University Grants Commission or Council of Scientific and Industrial Research as the case may be, or State Level Eligibility Test (SLET) or the State Eligibility Test (SET) is conducted by bodies accredited by the UGC for the said purpose, qualifying in NET/SLET/SET shall be an additional requirement.
 - 4. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET. Further, SLET/SET shall be valid as the minimum eligibility for direct recruitment to Universities/Colleges/Institutions in the respective state only.

II. For Medical Candidates: Relaxation up to three years in teaching experience may be given to candidates having MD/MS in the concerned subject from a recognized University.

Interested eligible candidates are requested to submit their application in the prescribed application form along with attested copies of certificates, testimonials etc., all required formats and one copy of recent passport size colour photograph.
