

3. Background:

The Regional Institute of Paramedical & Nursing Sciences (RIPANS) is an autonomous institution under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India. Recognized for its commitment to excellence in healthcare education, RIPANS has consistently strived to enhance its infrastructure to meet the evolving needs of its students and staff.

In the past years, RIPANS has faced a growing demand for water due to the expansion of its facilities and an increase in the number of students and staff. Recognizing the importance of sustainable water management, the institute has embarked on a mission to develop rainwater harvesting and water conservation infrastructure. These efforts are aimed at ensuring a reliable and sustainable water supply, reducing dependency on external water sources, and promoting environmental stewardship.

To achieve these goals, RIPANS has initiated several measures, including the construction of rainwater harvesting systems, installation of water-efficient fixtures, and implementation of awareness programs on water conservation. These steps reflect the institute's proactive approach to addressing water scarcity and its commitment to creating a sustainable campus environment.

4. AIMS & OBJECTIVES:

- a. RIPANS proposed to develop Rainwater Harvesting / Water Conservation Infrastructure within the campus to accumulate maximum rainfall from the terrace floor and runoff water.
- b. To meet the increasing demands of water.
- c. Collected rainwater utilised for flushing and secondary purpose.
- d. To reduce water tanker requirements.
- e. Recharge ground water and increase the level of water table.

5. BROAD SCOPE OF WORK

To carry out the project the campus land area acquires 53007sqm while the total terrace/floor is approx. 45674.97Sqm are required to gather rainfall through appropriate facilities.

A. Site Assessment and Feasibility Study

- i. Conduct a thorough assessment of the campus to identify optimal locations for rainwater harvesting.
- ii. Evaluate existing water usage patterns and identify areas for conservation improvements.

- iii. Prepare a feasibility report with recommendations for rainwater harvesting and water conservation measures.
- B. Design and Engineering**
 - i. Design a rainwater harvesting system, including storage tanks, filtration units, and distribution systems.
 - ii. Develop water conservation strategies, such as low-flow fixtures, and landscape irrigation improvements.
 - iii. Ensure that designs comply with local regulations and standards.
- C. System Integration**
 - i. Integrate the rainwater harvesting system with existing water supply systems.
 - ii. Ensure seamless operation and easy access for maintenance.
 - iii. Install monitoring and control systems to track water usage and system performance.
- D. Testing and Commissioning**
 - i. Test all components of the rainwater harvesting and water conservation systems.
 - ii. Commission the systems to ensure they are fully operational and meet design specifications.

8. VALID OF OFFER:

9. BIDDING TERMS AND QUALIFICATION CRITERIA :

9.1 Rights to the content of the proposal

For all the bids received before the last date and time of bid submission, the proposals and accompanying documentation will become the property of RIPANS and will not be returned after opening of the pre-qualification proposals. RIPANS is not restricted in its rights to use or disclose any or all of the information contained in the proposal and can do so without compensation to the bidders. RIPANS shall not be bound by any language in the proposal indicating the confidentiality of the proposal or any other restriction on its use or disclosure.

9.2 Acknowledgement of understanding of terms

By submitting a proposal, each bidder shall be deemed to acknowledge that it has carefully read all sections of this EoI, including all forms, schedules and annexure hereto, and has fully informed itself as to all existing conditions and limitations.

9.3 Evaluation of pre-qualification proposal

The bidders' Pre-Qualification Proposal in the bid document will be evaluated as per the requirements specified in the EoI and adopting the pre-qualification criteria spelt out in this EoI. The Bidders are required to submit all required documentation in support of the prequalification criteria specified as required for evaluation.

9.4 Language of proposals

The proposal and all correspondence and documents shall be written in English.

10. Conflict of Interest:

11.1 Where there is any indication that a conflict of interest exists or may arise, it shall be the responsibility of the Bidder to inform RIPANS, detailing the conflict in writing as an attachment to this Bid.

11.2 RIPANS will be the final arbiter in cases of potential conflicts of interest. Failure to notify RIPANS of any verbal or written agreement.

11.3 A Conflict of Interest is where a person who is involved in the procurement has or may be perceived to have a personal interest in ensuring that a particular Bidder is

successful. Actual and potential conflicts of interest must be declared by a person involved in a Bid process.

II. CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THIS EOI IS ISSUED

- (i) This EOI is not an offer and is issued with no commitment. RIPANS reserves the right to withdraw the EOI and change or vary any part thereof at any stage. RIPANS also reserves the right to disqualify any bidder, should it be so necessary at any stage.
